Step 1


Preparing the Axle:

Start by removing the axles from the housing. Remove the 10 nuts holding the differential in place. Slide the differential out of the housing. Remove all 10 studs from the housing. Clean off all remains of the previous differential gasket. For ease of installation, we recommend chasing all threads before continuing.



Install Studs:

Place one flat washer onto each new bolt. Thread each bolt in from the inside of the housing. Blue LocTite® can be used if desired. Tighten studs with a 5mm allen wrench. **Note:** If you are using a Rock AssaultTM Housing, see Step 3.



Step 3 (Optional)

If you are using a Trail-Gear housing, you will need to use the included 25mm and 30mm bolts in the bottom two holes of the housing. These bolts should be inserted from the outside, into the housing. The 30mm bolt goes into the hole located within the raised surface (green) while the 25mm bolt is inserted into the remaining hole (red).



Install Differential:

Once all 10 Studs have been installed, spread out a thin layer of Ultra Grey® silicon over the face of the 3rd member. Slide the 3rd member back into position on the housing. Place a lock washer and nut on each stud. Tighten nuts in a star pattern.

Reinstall axles into the housing and fill the differential with gear lube. Recheck nuts after the first trail run.
